


## Re-Configuring Thunderbird™ for the new Spitfire mail service.

Select your account from the list on the left hand side.



Under “Accounts” select “View settings for this account”.



Click on “Server Settings”

Change the “**Server Name**” to “mail2.spitfireuk.net”


